KINDERGARTEN:

- 2 – packs of #2 pencils 2 – pink erasers
- 1 – watercolor paint set
- 5 – boxes of 24 count crayons
- 20 – glue sticks (Elmer's)
- 1 – pack of Expo dry erase markers
- 1 – pair of safety scissors (Fiskars)
- 1 – plastic pencil box
- 1 – clear plastic zipper 3-ring pencil pouch
- 1 – plastic folder with pockets & prongs
- 1 ½ inch 3-ring binder with pockets

FIRST GRADE: (Do not label supplies)

- 2 – 24 pack of #2 pencils (prefer Ticonderoga)
- 1 – pair of scissors (Fiskars)
- 1 – pack of washable marker (prefer Crayola)
- 3 – boxes of 24 count crayons (Crayola)
- 12 – glue sticks (Elmer's)
- 2 – packs of 3 x 3 Post-it notes
- 3 – plastic folders with pockets & prongs
(purple, yellow & green)

SECOND GRADE:

- 4 – packs of #2 pencils 2 – yellow highlighters
- 3 – large glue sticks 1 - dry erase marker
- 2 – packs of 24 count crayons
- 2 – pair of scissors (Fiskars)
- 4 - pink oblong erasers (not the pencil type)
- 1 – pack of 3 x 3 Post-its notes
- 2 – plastic school boxes (**No** larger than 8 x 5½)
- 3 – plastic folders w/ pockets & prongs (red, blue, green)
- 2 – single subject wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- 2 – 1 ½ inch view binders and a package of dividers
- 1 - small Elmer's glue plastic bottle
- ***Optional***package of colored pencils

THIRD GRADE:

- 2 – folders with pockets & prongs
(blue & purple)
- 3 – dozen of #2 pencils
- 1 – 3-ring zipper pouch
- 2 – packs of 24 count crayons
- 2 – block erasers
- 3 – boxes of cap erasers
- 1 – pack of thin markers
- 2 – single subject spiral notebooks
- 4 – large glue sticks
- 1 – pair of scissors
- 2 – yellow highlighters
- 1 – pack of sticky notes 3x3 or smaller
- 1 – 1 ½ inch binder with pockets

FOURTH GRADE:

- 1 – nylon zipper pouch (**No** boxes, please)
- 1 – pair of scissors

- 4 – plastic folders with prongs
(red, blue, green & yellow)
- 1 – pack of colored pencils
- 1 - ruler
- 1 – pack of 16 count crayons
- 2 – packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 3 – packs of #2 pencils (**No** mechanical pencils)
- 4 – composition books (**No** spiral notebooks)
- 4 – glue sticks
- 1 - 1 ½ inch 3 ring binder w/ pockets

FIFTH GRADE:

(blue, yellow, red, green)
- 1 – pair of scissors (Fiskars)
- 2 – packs of wide ruled notebook paper
- 2 – packs of #2 pencils (**No** mechanical pencils)
- 2 – composition books
- 1 – nylon zipper pouch (**No** school boxes)
- 1 – pack of colored pencils
- 4 – large glue sticks

- 1 – pack of dividers with at least 5 subjects
- 1 – pack of cap erasers

- Pencil sharpener that collects shavings

- 1 – set of colored pencils (**No** markers)
- 1 – pack of 3 x 5 index cards
- 2 – 3 subject spiral notebooks blue & red
- 1 – 1 inch binder for math
- 6 – **Only plastic folders** with pockets & **PRONGS**
as listed - yellow(Social Studies); red (Math);
green (Science); blue (Language Arts);
2 purple (reading)
- 1 -1 subject notebook (green)
- 1 - composition book (Science Fair)
